OLD BUSINESS

The bid for replacement of the playground surface at Dorothy Drennon Park with poured-inplace rubber surfacing will happen at 11:00am on Tuesday, June 20th. The Park District is not going to bid for playground equipment since the only pieces replaced are the spring riders, which will be replaced with a spin component. The cost of removal, equipment, and installation should fall below the bid threshold.
